BASIC APPROACH



Research and plant native nectar-rich flowers that are known to attract butterflies and avoid using chemical pesticides that harm pollinators.

CREATIVE APPROACH



Create a community initiative to distribute butterfly-friendly plants to locals/ neighbors, and organize workshops on butterfly gardening.

Arrange and find space for the garden
