Meeting and socializing with citizens who live in your neighborhood can be fun by organizing a barter market. Find a suitable space, secure permission to occupy it, and organize, for example, every last sunday of the month a market where everyone can bring items they no longer use to exchange for the items of some other citizen. Create a project like that of "Riciclamiche," to make sure it becomes something recognizable. You could organize the barter market at different points in the city, involving other neighborhoods as well. It could become a traveling market, with a different manager for each neighborhood/city!
