## What is it about?

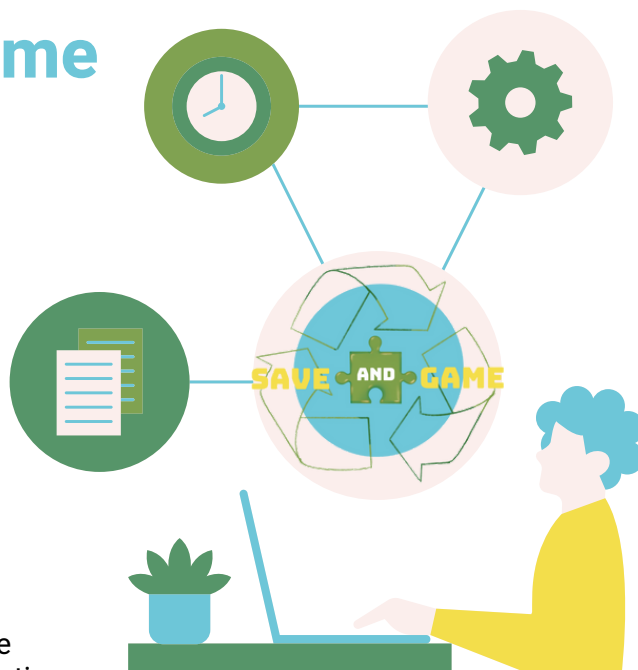
Creating a path for using Action Sheets with your youth group

## Why could it be useful?

It helps you plan actions to make the activity engaging and participatory, reminding you of the importance of disseminating results.

## Who is involved in its implementation?

A group of young people, your network of contacts (online and offline), any stakeholders envisaged in the specific Action Sheet you have decided to implement



### Brief description

In the Save&Game project you will find a series of Action Sheets. They are guides on how to implement actions to improve sustainability. They are divided into categories. Each sheet shows two possible implementations, one basic and one creative. In addition, you will find a link that allows you to take inspiration from an already implemented project.

### Suggestions

- Read the Action Sheets on the website
- Choose the one you think is most suitable in your area to start working on sustainability
- Involve any indicated stakeholders to check you have the collaborations you need
- Start the dissemination among young people in your area and ensure that those interested in participating can contact you to get involved
- Organise a meeting to present the action and gather further ideas from the young people involved
- Define an action plan with them by following the advice in the Action Sheet!

### Do!

Find a way to evaluate the progress and results of your action. Make sure you inform the community! You can increase the number of young people involved in the next actions and find acceptance among citizens and stakeholders!

### Don't!

Do not involve young people without making them part of the journey and the goals to be achieved. Do not impose actions/responsibilities but concert with them. Don't forget to share the results you are achieving with your commitment.
